AFLW players have lodged their votes on the Collective Bargaining Agreement proposal negotiated between the AFL and the AFLPA for the 2020-2022 seasons, with 70% of player votes supporting the proposal and 30% not supporting it.

Despite the majority of players voting in support of the deal, the AFLPA sought a player support vote of 75% or more to move forward with an approved CBA and therefore the deal is not yet approved.

The AFLPA will now conduct a series of meetings with players to determine the next steps in this process.
