

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Mason Cox Boots - Silent Auction

This document sets out the terms of participation in the Mason Cox Boots silent auction (the "**Auction**").

1. The Auction is being held by the AFL Players' Association, (ABN: 25695729819) (Association Reg: A0025229Z) Level 2, 170 Bridport Street, Albert Park 3206 ("AFLPA").
2. Bidder must register in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. By entering the Auction, each bidder agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. All relevant instructions on the AFLPA's website (if any) form part of these Terms and Conditions
3. The item being auctioned is a pair of autographed boots owned and worn by Mason Cox ("Boots") in the AFL match between Collingwood and Port Adelaide on 18 August 2018. All funds raised in the Auction shall be donated to a registered charitable organization for the purposes of drought relief.
4. Bidding is only open to "Eligible Bidders". An Eligible Bidder is an individual who is an Australian resident aged 18 years or older as at time of entry, excluding any: (i) employee or director of an employee or director of the AFLPA or any of its related agencies or companies and (ii) spouse, defacto spouse, parent, child or sibling of an excluded employee or director.
5. There is no reserve price.
6. Bids may only be made through the AFL Players' Association website: aflplayers.com.au.
7. The Auction opens at 17:00 (AEST) on August 15, 2018 and closes at 17:00 (AEST) on 21 August 2018 ("**Auction Period**"). Any bid received after the expiry of the Auction Period will be deemed invalid. No responsibility is accepted for late, lost, delayed or misdirected bids.
8. To enter the Auction, you must complete the mandatory fields. Each bid must include the mandatory fields or it will be deemed invalid.
9. The Eligible Bidder with the highest bid as at 17:00 on 21 August 2018 will receive the item. If there are two or more identical bids, then the Eligible Bidder who bid first will receive the Boots.
10. By submitting your bid to the AFLPA, you grant the AFLPA and its licensees and assignees a non-exclusive license to exercise all rights in perpetuity throughout the world in your bid and all other material provided by you to the AFLPA pursuant to this Auction at any time.
11. To the full extent permitted by the law, the AFLPA will not be liable for any injury, damages, expenses, or loss whatsoever (whether direct or consequential) to persons or property as a result of any person entering into the Auction, including without limitation damage to the Boots or failure of the delivery service.
