In celebration of National Reconciliation Week, the AFL Players' Association has launched its updated **Indigenous Map**.

The map highlights the cultural diversity of the AFL's Indigenous players, with the league's **87** male players and **22** female players represented across more than **71** cultural and language groups.

The AFLPA Indigenous Map was first produced in 2005, with the online versions becoming available in 2014.
